| Additional Duties for Certified Staff (IEP writing, Program Improvement, Instructional Support, and like positions) | Based on \$25 \$35/hour (Stipend / Timesheet) |
| Additional Duties for Certified Staff (based on federal, state, and local grant requirements) | Varies per grant requirements, grant budget and staff assignment |

| Auxiliary – Activities Supervisor (Certified Employee) Paid from site funds. | \$ 25.00 \$35/hour |
| Community Education - Athletic Camps, Clinics, Supervision of Students (to include weight room, camp coaching, student clinics and like positions) | \$20.00 \$35/hour |
| Lifeguard | \$13.85 \$15/hour |
| Medical supervision of athletic games (Nurse (RN), Athletic Trainer) | \$30 \$35/ game hour (Exempt) Non-exempt employees receive their hourly rate of pay |
